Course Aim This course is designed for members who are interested in learning more about the roles of a jumping judge and/or would like to commence their accreditation. Also suitable as a refresher and part-promotion course for EA Level 1.

EA Level 1 Jump Judging course will be held in Darwin later in the year.

Accreditation Requirements All members are encouraged to attend for personal development. However, to obtain full accreditation as a Jumping Judge, you must be:

Preliminary Jumping Judge

- At least 18 years of age
- A current financial member of ENT/EA
- Complete the Preliminary application form and return. Copy will be provided on request

EA Level 1 Judge

- At least 18 years of age
- A current financial member of ENT/EA
- Complete the required application form and return. Copy will be provided on request
- Attend an EA approved Jumping Judge clinic or seminar held over two days, during the last three years, but not necessarily concurrently
- Complete the current Jumping Judge open rule book test with a pass mark of at least 85%
- Meet the practical experience requirements

However, to obtain full accreditation as a EA Level 3 Jumping Judge, you must</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be a current financial member of ENT/EA - Be a currently registered EA Level 2 Jumping Judge - Attend an EA Judges Level 3 course - Attend an EA Jumping Course Designers Course in the previous three years - Pass EA Jumping Judge Open Rule Book Test - Be nominated by two judges of FEI Level 2 or higher - Officiated as a EA Level 2 judge at a minimum of six events in the previous two years - Worked as an assistant at two separate EA or FEI events with two different FEI level 2 Judges or higher in the previous two years |
